

The PEI Smoking Cessation Program is here to help all Island residents who smoke, vape or use other tobacco products, and are ready to quit.

WHAT DOES THE PROGRAM COVER?

The PEI Smoking Cessation Program covers the cost of one complete course (6-18 weeks in a row) of treatment, once per year, for one of the following products:

- Nicotine Replacement Therapy (NRT): Nicotine patch, gum, lozenge, or inhaler
- Prescription quit smoking medication: Bupropion (brand name: Zyban®) or Varenicline (brand name: Champix®)

OR USING OTHER TOBACCO PRODUCTS?

Note: Tobacco use in this booklet refers to commercial tobacco, not ceremonial tobacco.



How can I access the program?

Make an appointment with your nearest Primary Care Network office or visit your local pharmacy to discuss how ready you are to quit smoking, vaping or using other tobacco products and the supports available to you. Following your appointment, visit your local pharmacy to pick up your NRT product or cessation medication.



What if I only vape nicotine?

The PEI SCP offers vaping cessation support by means of nicotine replacement therapy products for eligible PEI residents who wish to stop vaping.



What are nicotine replacement therapy (NRT) products?

Nicotine replacement therapy products are over-the-counter medications that contain nicotine. They can help you quit smoking or vaping by allowing you to slowly reduce the amount of nicotine in your body.



What are prescription smoking cessation medications?

Bupropion and Varenicline do not contain nicotine. They act on the brain to help you quit smoking and reduce cravings. Discuss with your primary health care provider if these medications might be right for you.
